The village of Montertelot, on the banks of the river Oust, offers a wide range of outdoor activities:

- the Oust is part of the Canaux de Bretagne network, and can be navigated from April to October.
- The towpath and the "Questembert-Mauron" greenway, which passes close to Montertelot, are ideal for cycling and hiking.

To get to know the region, we suggest you visit Tourisme Destination Brocéliande, the Ploërmel tourist office (02 97 22 36 43) and MORBIHAN.COM.

Services in the commune or nearby:

- 5 km away, the town of Ploërmel (weekly market on Friday mornings).
